

## Precursor Adds Accessibility to Managed Software Center

Precursor Systems is pleased to announce that that we added a utility to open the Accessibility system preference pane to the Managed Software Center featured items.

Apple provides a host of Accessibility (Universal Access) capabilities in the operating system in the categories Vision, Motor, Hearing, and Cognitive. Customizing these options is part of the setup process of every device. But after system setup these options may be hard to find for some users.

In her MacSysAdmin 2021 presentation "*Inclusive Design for Mac Admins*", Dr. Emily Kausalik-Whittle suggests making a shortcut to these preferences available in self-service portals such as Jamf and the munki Managed Software Center. As we have made an extensive set of self-service tools for Managed Software Center we decided to add this tool.

A self-serve Accessibility tool now lives as a feature item in the Precursor implementation of Managed Software Center. And other Mac Admins who wish to use it are free to use the configuration we made (or any of the other self-service tools) available at our github repo: <https://github.com/precursorca/Munki-SelfService-On-Demand>
