## LaserWriter 8.5.1 !

On November 18 Apple released its new PostScript Level 3 print driver LaserWriter version 8.5.1. The new software ships with Apple's first PostScript 3 printer –the LaserWriter 8500– and is available on the internet. LaserWriter 8.5.1 supports all the PostScript 3 printing additions including printing over TCP/IP on the internet. And, because users overwhelmingly demanded it the new driver will direct to PDF format (providing the user also has Adobe's Acrobat Distiller software installed). LaserWriter 8.5.1 is available as 6 disk images on-line at:

## Apple 2/3/4/6 GB Firmware Utility !

Apple has just released a utility to fix a problem with a limited number of 2, 3, 4, and 6 GB SCSI hard drives in some Power Macintosh and Performa configurations that may experience a problem waking after the machines has been set to the Sleep mode. You can use "Apple System Profiler" to check the firmware version of your drive (choose Device Information: the firmware version will be displayed as the Revision Number). The 2/3/4/6 GB Firmware Utility is needed only if the firmware version is not 0F0J.
