Acrobat InProduction is a new set of tools for working with PDF at the production level: **Pre-flight** Analyze and correct problems in PDF files with user-definable profiles; **Trim/Bleed** Define media, bleed, trim, and art boxes; **Color Converter** Convert and tag/untag LAB, RGB, and CMYK colors using ICC profiles; **Separator** Preview and map color plates and output files for separation; **Adobe in-RIP Trapping** Specify page and zone-based trapping parameters. InProduction requires Acrobat 4.0.5. Promotional pricing in effect until October 15, 2000 is \$699 US or \$499 US for the web download version.
