### **Adobe Announces Photoshop 6**

Adobe announced Photoshop 6.0 at this week's Seybold conference. Photoshop 6.0 is bursting with feature enhancements and interface improvements. Beta testers, eager to finally be able to talk, have mentioned the "agony" of going back to version 5.5. Photoshop 6 includes –among many other things– tighter integration with ImageReady 3.0; a new type engine that finally allows the direct entry and manipulation of text; and the ability to save Photoshop files in PDF native (similar to Illustrator 9).

Photoshop 6 can be ordered now and is expected to be shipped in late September. Upgrades from previous versions are \$199 US.
