Macromedia is first to the table with a major Macintosh application made for OS X. Actually, version 10 works both in Mac OS 9 and Msc OS X. The new version offers a host of feature improvements and moves to a standard Macromedia user interface. The company claims performance under OS X is better. You can download version 10 today from the Macromedia web site for only \$129 US. Users who require the Mac OX 10 version of the software will have to order the boxed version until Macromedia updates its on-line store to deliver OS X materials. http://www.macromedia.com/software/freehand/

Mac OS X 10.0.3

In record time Apple has released a third update to Mac OS X. The new 10.0.3 update provides performance and stability improvements and requires that Mac OS X 10.0.1 be installed. Apple CarbonLib 1.3.1

CarbonLib 1.3.1 improves compatibility for applications that utilize Apple's Carbon Library (such as Aladdin's StuffIt version 6 or higher).

Apple Open Transport 2.6.7

Open Transport 2.6.7 fixes a minor problem in Mac OS 9.1's networking where the apparently, the system doesn't "behave as expected". It is currently available via the Software Update control panel and should be available as a download later this week.

Apple's Authoring Support 1.1 offers increased compatibility for burning CD's to third party drives when using iTunes and Disc Burner.
