Version 10.1.5 increases the stability of Mail and Sherlock, adds support for numerous peripherals and provides many other improvements and bug fixes. The update works on 10.1.3 and 10.1.4. To upgrade from 10.1-10.1.2 you can use the Combo updater.

Macromedia is now shipping the companion applications to Flash MX (see *Precursor PDF News* 16/03). The best deal is to purchase/upgrade to Macromedia Studio and get Flash MX, DreamWeaver MX, FireWorks MX and FreeHand 10. The applications all run natively in both OS 9 and OS X. Macromedia has standardized the user interface and loaded up on features too.
