Quark 6.0 -the wait is over?

On Tuesday, June 10, Quark announced that Quark 6 will ship next week. For many digital publishers this is the last obstacle remaining in the switch to Mac OS X. We examine this important development:

Features

QuarkXPress 6 is finally Mac OS X native. It will now include: Multiple undo and redo support; Full PDF creation support along with retention of spot colours; New project files will allow users to share attributes and information (share style sheets, colors, hyphenation settings and lists) in complex projects that include multiple versions of print and Web pages in varying sizes and orientations; Synchronized Text will let users share content among layouts with live update capabilities; Tables support is said to be greatly improved; Web-page conversion features introduced in Version 5 are extended with enhancements including rollovers, menus, hyperlinks, font-family management, and preview and export controls.

Availability

While Quark's press release says shipping will start within one week, Internet reports quote Quark's phone operators as telling people that delivery could be delayed to late July.

Readiness

Will QuarkXPress 6 be ready for prime time? Historically, the company has usually needed at least one minor upgrade under it's belt to deal with bugs –Quark 4, 4.0.1 4.02, 4.03 were all unusable in a production environment. Nevertheless, Quark has had more than enough time to get this right. XPress 6 is the last major application to be ported to OS X and we expect quality control to be higher this time.

Pricing

Quark's Canadian distributors have not announced Canadian pricing as of this writing but version 6 will be available for \$1045 U.S. at the company's web site. Upgraders from 5 can get it for \$199; from 4.0 for \$399 U.S. and from 3.0 for \$499 U.S.
